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STANDING ORDER

Whereas, amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure changing the time computation provisions of Rule 9006 and adopting multiples of seven (7) days for deadlines less than thirty (30) days will become effective December 1, 2009; and

Whereas, the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure contain deadlines inconsistent with those amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; it is hereby

**ORDERED**, that the following changes to the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure are adopted as of December 1, 2009, for the purposes of consistency with the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure:


- 5 days are lengthened to 7 days in Local Rule 7054-1(A).
- 5 days are lengthened to 7 days, and 8 days are lengthened to 10 days in Local Rule 9013-1(B).
- 10 days are lengthened to 14 days in Local Rules 1015-1(B), 2007-1.1(C), 2016-2(A), 2091-1(B) and 2091-1(C).
- 15 days are shortened to 14 days in Local Rules 9014-1(A) and 9014-1(C).
- 20 days are lengthened to 21 days in Local Rules 6004-1(B) and 6007-1(B)

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**


