ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Officers upon entry, members of the media may bring laptop, tablet, and notebook computers into the United States Bankruptcy Court Clerk's Office of this District for the sole purpose of recording information obtained from the public access terminals located therein. Members of the media may not use any device to photograph, broadcast, transmit, or conduct audio or video recordings. The devices must be silenced at all times and they may not be used in any other area of the Bankruptcy Court, including courtrooms and lobbies outside of courtrooms, for any reason. Any member of the media who violates this Order will be prohibited from bringing such devices into the Bankruptcy Clerk's Office in the future. The Chief District Judge, Chief Bankruptcy Judge, or Clerk of Bankruptcy Court may suspend the privileges granted by this Order at any time, for any reason.
