

## Do you need an E-Filing account?

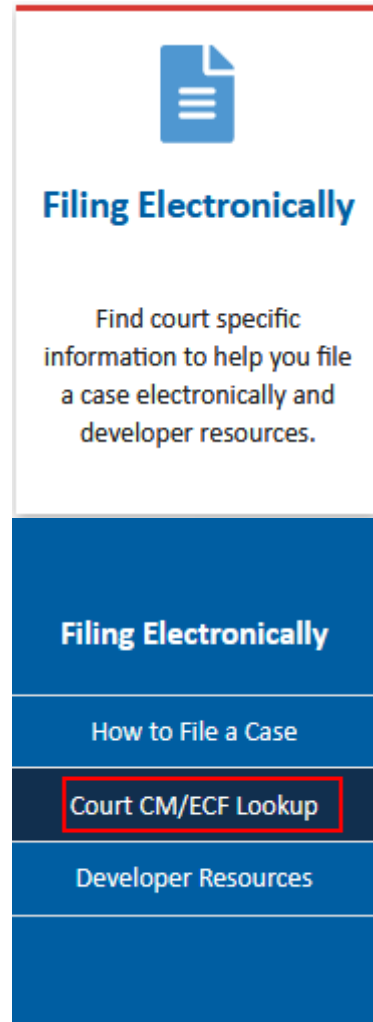

Did you know that you only need one PACER account to view documents and case dockets across the entire country in Bankruptcy Courts, District Courts and Appellate Courts?

\*\*You should only register for an e-filing account(CM/ECF) if you will be filing documents or pleadings in a case; ie: file a motion, file a reaffirmation agreement, file a Proof of Claim, etc.

1. Go to PACER's website at: [www.pacer.uscourts.gov](http://www.pacer.uscourts.gov)

Hover over: **Filing Electronically**

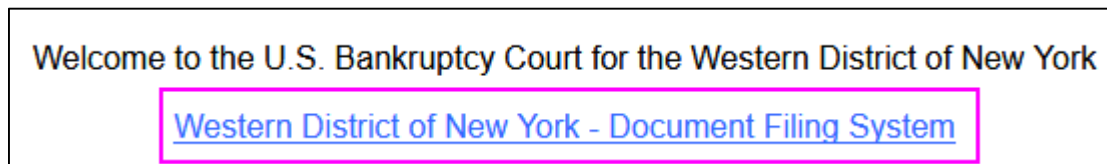


3. Click on: **Court CM/ECF Lookup**

4. Click on the Court link you wish to access

5. Click on the link: **Document Filing System**
