ELIMINATION OF REDUNDANT PAPER NOTICING BY COURT

The implementation of CM/ECF gives the Clerk's Office the ability to provide registered e-filers with electronic notice through e-mail. The additional notice provided in paper through the Bankruptcy Noticing Center ("BNC") is redundant and has become burdensome to most registered e-filing attorneys. This Court, in partnership with the Delaware Bankruptcy Court, has developed a national software solution that will eliminate the redundant BNC paper notices for registered e-filers.

As authorized by Administrative Order No. 6, effective December 1, 2004, duplicate paper noticing by the Clerk's Office will be discontinued, except for the "Notice of the First Meeting of Creditors." The "Notice of the First Meeting of Creditors" will continue to be sent by the BNC through the mail, as well as by e-mail, as this notice provides parties with the debtor(s)' complete social security number.

Parties wishing to continue to receive redundant paper notices through the BNC must make a request, in writing, to the Clerk of Court.
