NOTICE OF TEMPORARY AMENDMENTS TO THE BANKRUPTCY CODE AND TO OFFICIAL BANKRUPTCY FORMS, EFFECTIVE APRIL, 2020, DUE TO THE ENACTMENT OF THE CARES ACT

Notice No. 20-01

On March 27, 2020, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) was enacted. Among other things, upon its enactment, the CARES Act amends provisions of different chapters of the Bankruptcy Code, most of them temporarily for one year.

Five Official Bankruptcy Forms have been amended to incorporate the relevant substantive changes provided for by the CARES Act. The Official Forms that have been amended effective immediately are: 101 and 201 (Voluntary Petition Forms); and 122A-1, 122B, and 122C-1 (means test forms). These forms are set to expire one year from the CARES Act enactment date. The forms can be found at www.uscourts.gov.
