NOTICE OF EXPIRATION OF THE BANKRUPTCY THRESHOLD ADJUSTMENT AND TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS ACT (BTATC ACT) AND CHANGES TO OFFICIAL FORMS 101 AND 201 AS A RESULT THEREOF

Notice No. 24-01

The BTATC Act expired at midnight on June 21, 2024. These provisions affected several code sections, including the definition of a "debtor" in subchapter V and debt amounts to determine eligibility for chapter 13 cases. Interim Rule 1020 also became inapplicable after June 21, 2024.

There are also changes to the voluntary petition forms:

- Official Form 101, question 13
- Official Form 201, question 8

The new forms became effective on June 22, 2024, and are available on the uscourts.gov website. The current version of Official Forms 101 and 201 should be used immediately for any new case filings.

You should consult the affected code provisions and rule, as well as the Official Forms, to determine the impact on your bankruptcy filings.
