In addition to the \$952.00 and \$4710.00 previously allowed, Howard F. Gondree, Esq. seeks \$937.50 in additional fees, \$72.00 in disbursements, and \$719.46 in interest on unpaid allowances.

The U.S. Trustee has objected to the claim for interest. This objection is sustained. There is no basis for a claim for interest on unpaid allowances.


The U.S. Trustee has also objected to the form of Mr. Gondree's application in that it cannot be determined whether his claimed time is reasonable. That office requests denial of the application until adequate time records are submitted.

I note that Chapter 11 administrative claims in this case will receive only a few cents on the dollar. Rather than requiring that Mr. Gondree revise his application, I have reduced his \$937.50 request by one-third for lack of detail, and hereby allow \$625.

Mr. Gondree's claim #26 is therefore allowed as a Chapter 11 expense of administration in the total amount of \$5407.00 (\$4710. plus \$72. plus \$625.).
